Kayenta Animal Care Center, the “KACC,” is a multipurpose animal resource center for the Kayenta Township and surrounding communities.

The animal care center provides animal shelter, animal control services year around. Daily veterinary care services for pets include vaccinations, deworming, and other basic preventative care.

Monday – Friday

Open to Public: 1:00 pm to 5:00 pm

The Kayenta Animal Care Center is now a department of the Kayenta Township Commission. Dr. Charlotta Begaye serves as the Director of KACC.

Since the start of test case operations, KACC has sheltered displaced animals, provided veterinary care, assisted individual rescue efforts, and has worked with humane groups outside the Reservation.
